We had excellent feedback from the employer partners about student engagement and we are looking forward to seeing these sessions develop over the next few weeks.


## **UCAS Talk for Year 13**

## **Baseline assessments**

Next week we will have our first cognitive ability tests and reading tests for students in Year 10 and 12.

These will be held in class time and students will complete them on a laptop. Any student who doesn't have a laptop will be provided with one to use for the assessments.
