New information system and apps for parents

At UTC Reading we have just implemented a new data system called IRIS EdGen, which replaces the system we were using last year called Progresso Cloud School. We have had a few teething issues with getting this up and running in our first week and I would like to thank you for your patience and understanding whilst we work through this.

Next week, you will receive log in details for the system which you can access online or via the app. On this system you will be able to access student timetables, behaviour records and assessment records.

You will also receive a log in to Parent Mail for school communications and recording absences, and this is also our cashless system for the school where students can buy lunches and pay for trips and activities.
